



### **Emergency Planning Sub-Committee Chairman's Report**

1. The 52<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Emergency Planning Sub-Committee was held on the 13<sup>th</sup> of March 2006. This was the first meeting of the sub-committee to be open to the public. The Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA) had joined the sub-committee.
2. The committee agreed to postpone the election of Chairman and Vice-Chairman until the next meeting, as there were only two elected members present.
3. The committee received a report from British Nuclear Group Sellafield Limited on the five site exercises that had been held since the last report.
4. The committee were provided with the programme of forthcoming exercises, as follows:
  - 30<sup>th</sup> March 2006 A Level NII demonstration emergency exercise.
  - 16<sup>th</sup> May 2006 A demonstration exercise for the Office of Civil Nuclear Security.
5. The committee asked to be kept informed on how the issues arising from separating the Low Level Waste Repository from Sellafield would be addressed.
6. The committee asked to be informed of actions to avoid a reoccurrence of the AEA Technology transport flask event and why stakeholders had not been informed about this matter earlier.
