



### **Emergency Planning Sub-Committee Chairman's Report**

1. The 55<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Emergency Planning Sub-Committee was held on the 12<sup>th</sup> March 2007.
2. The committee agreed to postpone the election of Chairman and Vice-Chairman until the after the local elections which will take place in May 2007.
3. The committee received a report from British Nuclear Group Sellafield Limited on the three site exercises that had been held since the last report. The committee also received a report from UKAEA on the Windscale site exercise that had been held since the last report. They also received a brief report on the Level 3 Off Site exercise OSCAR 8.
4. The committee were provided with the programme of forthcoming exercises, as follows:  
British Nuclear Group:
  - 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2007 This will be a full site demonstration exercise (level 1)
  - 5<sup>th</sup> June 2007 This will be a full site demonstration exercise (level 1) and will be run out of hours exercise.
  - 21<sup>st</sup> November 2007 This will be a full site demonstration exercise (level 1)UKAEA:
  - May/June 2007 Date to be confirmed. The Windscale annual CT exercise.
5. The committee was updated on the issues surrounding the site siren. It was explained that BNGSL was in the process of setting up the Public Telephone helpline and that a new version of the Householders leaflet would be issued in conjunction with this to explain the new helpline.
6. The committee was given a short presentation on Recovery Issues. It was explained that this issue was being taken on at a National level and that any new learning would be shared throughout the UK.
7. The committee was given a short presentation on the issues surrounding the disposal of contaminated milk following an incident at Sellafield.
