

**SUMMARY OF LLWR EMERGENCY ARRANGEMENTS PROGRESS
(Period September 2009 - March 2010)**

Operations Demonstration exercise

This was carried out on 12th November 2009 in the presence of NII and OCNS inspectors

The NII judged the exercise to be successful and noted that points of learning identified from the previous Demonstration exercise had been addressed and changes had been positively implemented.

The main points of learning from this exercise concerned evacuation of personnel from potentially affected buildings and the roll call infrastructure. These issues were addressed within a few days of the exercise and have since been successfully tested on more than one occasion.

General

- Emergency exercise programme running to schedule
- Next Demonstration exercise to be carried out on 15th July 2010
- Exercise outcomes continue to be tracked ensuring learning improvements are implemented

Radsafe

LLWR has expanded its business to include the recycling of metallic LLW thereby reducing the amount of waste emplaced in the vaults at LLWR. Consequently, LLWR has become a Consignor of waste nationwide and thus has become a member of Radsafe. This provides for an immediate response in the event of a LLWR transport consignment being involved in a road or rail incident any where in the UK.
