# WCSSG role and purpose

- Forum for representation
- **NOT** policy development or decision making

# Meeting structure and timing

- Four main group meetings a year
- Timings based on NDA reporting schedule
- Focus on a consistent set of targets outlined in performance plan(s)
- Reports reflect structure of performance plan(s)
- Agendas to include progress against priority work streams and key issues raised in working groups

# Minutes and reports

- Summary reports from all meetings **not** verbatim transcript
- Main meetings will be recorded in case of need for clarification
- Reports will be succinct and in a consistent format

# WCSSG working groups

- Environmental Health, Emergency Planning and LLWR
- Remaining Sellafield issues – 3 different approaches
- Final proposal:
  - Risk & Hazard Reduction and Waste Management
  - Spent Fuel Management and Nuclear Materials
  - Decommissioning and End States
