REPORT FOR APRIL 2006

The 1st meeting of the West Cumbria Sites Stakeholder Group – Calder Hall Sub-Committee was held on Wednesday 15 February 2006 at the Ennerdale Country House Hotel, Cleator.

As this was the 1st meeting the Agenda focussed on agreeing the Terms of Reference for the Calder Hall Sub-Committee as these define the objectives and purpose of the meeting as well as the roles and responsibilities of the Chairman and the Secretary. The Chairman and the Vice-Chairman were also elected.
