



Emergency Planning Sub-Committee Chairman's Report

1. The 57th meeting of the Emergency Planning Sub-Committee was held on the 10th March 2008.
2. The chairman expressed great concern at the continuing poor attendance at the meetings.
3. The committee received reports from Sellafield Ltd and UKAEA Windscale on the site exercises that had been held since the last meeting.
4. The committee were provided with the programme of forthcoming exercises, as follows:
Sellafield Ltd:
 - 8th May 2008, this will be a full site demonstration exercise (level 1).
 - 4th June 2008, this will be a Transport Emergency Exercise.
 - 9th October 2008, this will be a test of the on and off site emergency plan.
 - 27th November 2008, this will be a full site demonstration exercise (level 1).
5. The committee agreed that LLWR should be required to attend the meetings in future.
6. The committee was updated on the changes to the Sellafield On and Off site Emergency Plans, the associated changes to the householders leaflet and the importance of good stakeholder communication to ensure that the changes were well known and understood. The key change is that from 1st May Sellafield will have the ability to sound the siren at either a Site Incident or a Sellafield Emergency.
7. The committee were given an update on the project to replace the Sellafield site siren.
8. Sellafield Limited and Civil Nuclear Constabulary were asked to review their contingency plan for general public access through the site in the event that the A595 is closed.
