



Emergency Planning Sub-Committee Chairman's Report

1. The 56th meeting of the Emergency Planning Sub-Committee was held on the 10th September 2007.
2. The committee received a report from Sellafield Ltd on the three site exercises that had been held since the last report.
3. The committee were provided with the programme of forthcoming exercises, as follows:
Sellafield Ltd:
 - 21st November 2007 This will be a full site demonstration exercise (level 1)
 - 20th March 2008 This will be a full site Roll Call and Communications exercise.
 - 8th May 2008 This will be a full site demonstration exercise (level 1)
 - 9th October 2008 This will be a full site Roll Call and Communications exercise.
 - 27th November 2008 This will be a full site demonstration exercise (level 1)
4. The committee was updated on the issues surrounding the site siren. It was explained that Sellafield Ltd were waiting for the NII to give the final agreement to the new Emergency Plan as soon as this was agreed then the new version of the Householders leaflet would be issued in conjunction with this.
5. The committee was given a short brief on “Lessons Learnt from Buncefield”
6. The committee was updated on Recovery Issues at a National Level, it was explained that this issue was being looked at by Emergency Planners from all over the UK and that a National committee had been set up to discuss the issues.
