WHAT IS INS?

- Wholly-owned subsidiary of the NDA from 1 April 2008
- Previously 51% owned by Sellafield Ltd, 49% owned by NDA
- Employs approximately 150 people directly, approximately 150 people via subsidiaries
- People located at Pelham House, Risley, Barrow, Japan, France, Germany

WHAT DO WE DO?

- Manage existing contracts for services provided by Sellafield Ltd (primarily reprocessing and MOX fuel related contracts)
- Negotiate new contracts for services provided by Sellafield Ltd
- Operate an international nuclear transport service

MAIN CONTRACT SERVICES

- Transport of irradiated nuclear fuel to Sellafield
- Reprocessing of irradiated nuclear fuel
- Fabrication of MOX fuel
- Transport of MOX fuel to customers
- Return of uranium trioxide
- Return of waste products

NUCLEAR TRANSPORT SERVICES

- Operate a fleet of four ships (through subsidiary Pacific Nuclear Transport Ltd – PNTL)
- Operate the Ramsden Dock facility at Barrow
- Manage transport services between Sellafield and customers
- Manage transport services between France and Japan (on behalf of Areva)
- Provide an emergency management capability world-wide, including training for overseas emergency services
- Provide world-wide nuclear and non-nuclear transport charter services
