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LLWR Separation - NDA and BNGSL Commitment

Letter from Ian Roxburgh (CE, NDA) to Lawrie Haynes (CE, BNGSL):

- NDA intention to compete LLWR site by December 2006
- NDA requires a new, independent, Site Licence Company (SLC) be created out of the BNGSL SLC

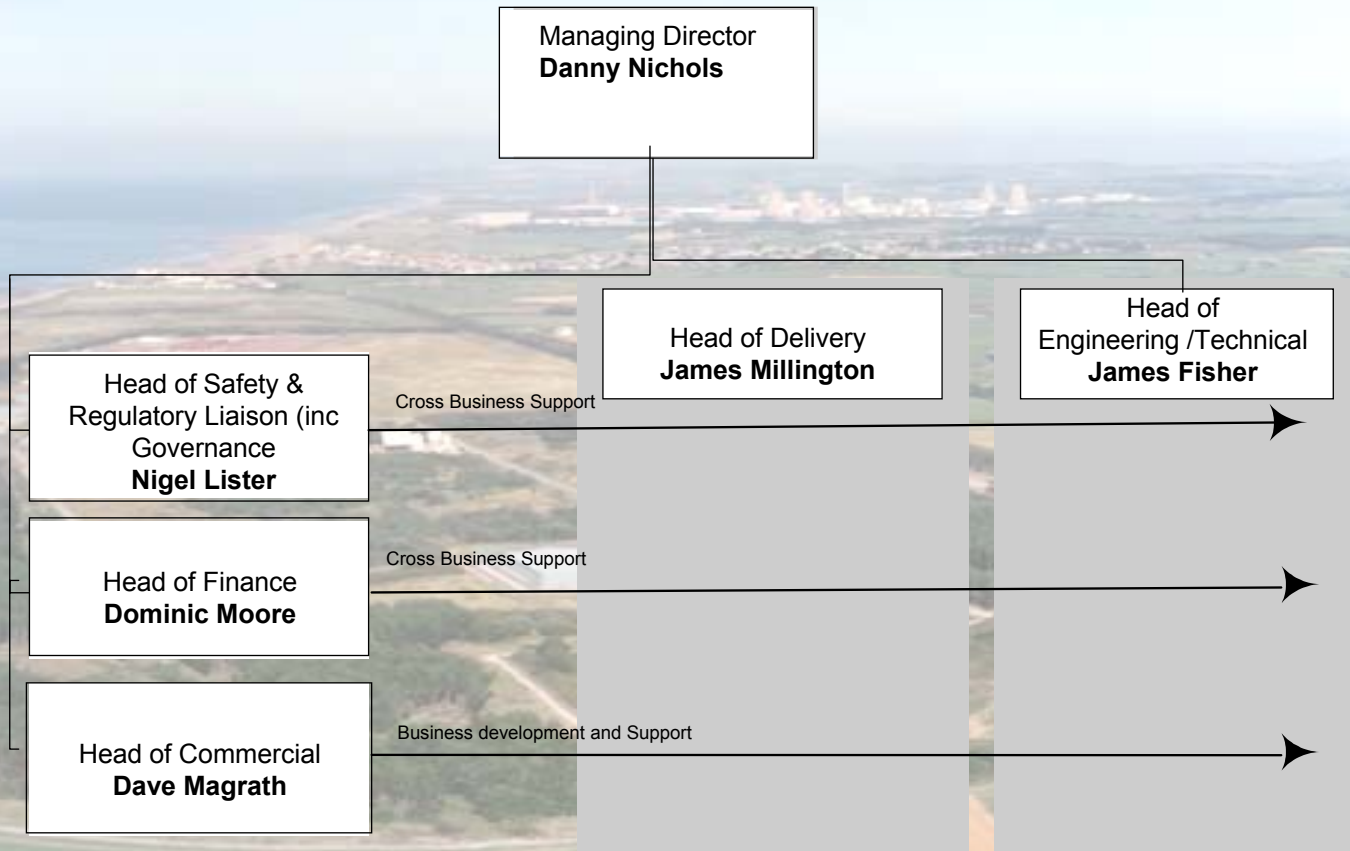
LLWR Separation: NDA Vision
