**NDA update on Socio-Economic activities and plans for the 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the Socio-Economic Sub-Committee on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2008.**

1. NDAs Socio-Economic Panel has met twice since the last Sub-Committee meeting. During these meetings the panel reviewed applications from West Cumbria based organisations, including:
  - a. Haig Colliery Museum
  - b. Egremont and District Pool Trust
  - c. Clean Energy Solutions Ltd
  - d. Hadrians Wall Trust
  - e. React Foundation
  
2. Following the publication of NDA Socio-Economic Policy, work has commenced on preparing the “bespoke” plans for each of the four priority areas. When drafted and agreed, these plans will describe in more detail how the NDA will contribute to the different socio-economic needs in each area.
  
3. The Copeland Community Fund Agreement is with BERR for agreement. It is anticipated that this will be approved by 19<sup>th</sup> September and that following signature by the three parties, the first payment will be made to the fund by the end of September.
  
4. Plans for the formal launch of the NDA Skills and Capability Strategy are being made for later in the year.
