



West Cumbria Sites Stakeholder Group – Windscale Sub-committee

Report for October 2005 Meeting

The inaugural meeting of the West Cumbria Sites Stakeholder Group – Windscale Sub-committee was held on Tuesday 6th September at the Cleator Moor Civic Hall.

As this was the first meeting, the main agenda focussed on agreeing the terms of reference for the meeting as these define the objectives and purpose of the meeting as well as the roles and responsibilities of the Chairman and the Secretary and electing a Chairman and Vice-chairman.

Terms of reference for the meeting were ratified at the inaugural meeting and will be made available on the West Cumbria Sites Stakeholder Group website along with the minutes of the meeting.

Mr Ranald Stewart, Parish Councillor for Ponsonby Parish Council was elected as Chairman of the Windscale Sub-committee.

Mr Ronald Hargreaves, Parish Councillor for St Johns and Beckermest was appointed as Vice-chairman of the meeting.

The Windscale Sub-committee will meet formally twice a year and the meetings will be held on the first Tuesday in March and September and will feed back to the formal West Cumbria Sites Stakeholder Group.

Mr Peter Mann, Head of Site, Windscale made a presentation to the meeting which included an overview of the Windscale site, the Windscale programme, performance and plans.

The members of the committee were asked to consider any issues which they would like to be included as future agenda items. Suggestions included; Socio-economic plans, UKAEA's Future Plans, Risk and Risk Mitigation.

The members of the Windscale Sub-committee were invited to visit the Windscale Site early in November for a site familiarisation visit. The visit will enable the members to meet some of the Windscale Team and become familiar with some of the projects which are being carried out on the site.
