

## **Report of the 58<sup>th</sup> Emergency Planning Sub Committee held on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2008**

1. The meeting welcomed the attendance of representatives from LLWR for the first time.
2. The meeting received reports on exercises held by Sellafield, Windscale and LLWR sites.
3. The Civil Nuclear Constabulary promised to provide the committee with exercise reports in the future.
4. The main exercises planned for the future are :
  - Sellafield will be holding a counter terrorism exercise on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2008.
  - Sellafield will be conducting a level 1 demonstration exercise on the 27<sup>th</sup> November 2008.
  - Civil Nuclear Constabulary will be holding an exercise on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2009.
  - Sellafield will be holding an off site emergency exercise on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2009
5. The committee received a report on the progress towards the installation of the new Sellafield site siren.
6. The committee agreed that more should be done to ensure that the changes to the way the Sellafield site siren is used in an emergency are understood by the community and that as a consequence Cumbria County Council Emergency Planning Unit had agreed to visit sensitive sites within a 6 km radius of the site.
7. Some inaccuracies in the WCSSG website, with regard to the Sellafield sites emergency arrangements had been noted and had been rectified.
8. A discussion was held on the introduction of the Airwave radio system for both Cumbria and Sellafield Fire and Rescue Services.
