Governance

- NDA Panel for amounts < £100k
- Soc Ec Cttee for amounts above
- Independent chair
- Amounts > £500k must be referred to BERR

Support via Operations

SLC level funding

- Sellafield £3.1 m
- No plans to cut or curtail
- Intra-regional support – WC & Furness
- Working to change to more strategic focus
- Need to manage exit from dependent recipients
